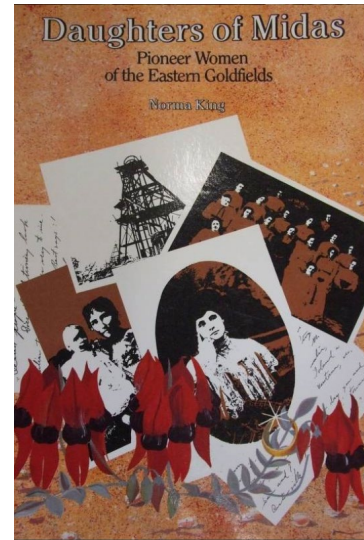


This digger's wife kept the flag flying and the mine going while her husband was on active service.
